SUBJECT: **Amendment No. 0003** to Specifications and Drawings for Construction of Building 100-101, Phase III, Iowa AAP, IA.

Solicitation No. DACA45 03 B 0001.

TO: Prospective Bidders and Others Concerned

1. The specifications and drawings for subject project are hereby modified as follows (revise accordingly).

a. Specifications. (Descriptive Changes.)

(1) **SF 1442, Page 00010-1**, delete date and time of bid opening shown and substitute "26 JUN 2003" at "2:00".

b. Specifications (New and/or Revised and Reissued). Delete and substitute or add specification pages as noted below. The substituted pages are revised and reissued with this amendment.

c. Drawings (Not Reissued). The following drawing sheets of drawing code F610-18-03 are revised as indicated below with latest revision date of 17 June 2003. These drawings are not reissued with this amendment.

(1) **Sheet A1.01:**

Add a General Note 10 to the sheet as follows:

"10. The area shall have 8 inch insulation with kraft face attached between the existing wood rafters. Rafters are on 16-inch centers. Existing drop ceiling shall be taken down to accommodate this work. A new 2'x 2' drop ceiling shall be provided in this area after the insulation work is completed."

(2) **Sheet MR.1 & M1.0:**

For Women's Toilet (New Room Number CS8), show an existing 2-inch floor drain in the center of this room. Lavs and water closets shall connect into the existing sanitary piping.

(3) **Sheet E5.01:**

- a) Change the 600A switch and 600A fuse serving Panel PP41 to 400A switch and 400A fuse.
- b) Change the 600A rating of Panel PP41 to 400A.
- c) Reroute the feeder serving Panel LP41 from Panel PP41 to the vault switchboard.
- d) Add/reuse a 200A switch and 200A fuse to serve Panel LP41.

(4) **Sheet E6.02:**

- a) Change Panel PP41 bus rating from 600 to 400A.
- b) Change Panel PP41 Main OC device from 500A to 400A.
- c) Remove the 200A subfeed breaker for Panel LP41.

2. This amendment is a part of the bidding papers and its receipt shall be acknowledged on the Standard Form 1442. All other conditions and requirements of the specifications remain unchanged. If the bids have been mailed prior to receiving this amendment, you will notify the office where bids are opened, in the specified manner, immediately of its receipt and of any changes in your bid occasioned thereby.

Cranes with one hundred and fifty (150) feet of boom or over, or one hundred (100) ton rated lifting capacity, or cranes with attachments of six (6) cubic yards or over will receive an additional thirty-five cents (.35) per hour over the aforementioned rate or \$1.10 per hour over the otherwise applicable per hourrate.

Tower cranes or cranes with two hundred (200) feet, of boom or over shall receive an additional forty cents (.40) per hour over the aforementioned rate, or one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per hour over the otherwise applicable rate.

#### WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- \* an existing published wage determination
- \* a survey underlying a wage determination
- \* a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- \* a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator (See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7). Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:
