TO: Prospective Offerors and Others Concerned

1. The specifications and drawings for subject project are hereby modified as follows (revise all specification indices, attachment lists, and drawing indices accordingly).

a. Specifications. (Descriptive Changes.)

(1) Section 00110, Page 10, paragraph 6.5.1, line 2, after first sentence reading "The Offeror ... complete the project.", insert:

"The number of days shall encompass both the Basic Items and all Options. The proposed number of days shall not be dependent or varied based upon which options are awarded."

(2) Section 00800, Page 10, paragraph 1.13.

(a) Line 1, after first sentence reading "The Contractor shall be ... digging permits.", insert:

"Prior to requesting the digging permit, the Contractor shall locate and flag all existing utilities in the vicinity of the areas encompassed by the digging permit application."

(b) Last 2 lines, delete last sentence reading "All utilities ... boring and jacking." and substitute:

"All utilities crossing beneath any paved road, driveway, parking lot, or hard-stand shall be installed via boring and jacking. This provision includes jacking and boring casing pipes, as necessary."

(3) General Wage Decision Nos. CO030012 and CO030014, delete General Wage Decision Nos. CO030012 and CO030014 in their entirety and substitute attached modified General Wage Decision Nos. CO030012 dated 12/05/2003 and CO030014 dated 09/19/2003.

b. Specifications (New and/or Revised and Reissued). Not Applicable.

In the listing above, the "SU" designation means that rates listed under the identifier do not reflect collectively bargained wage and fringe benefit rates. Other designations indicate unions whose rates have been determined to be prevailing.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator (See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7). Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:
