SUBJECT: Amendment No. 0001 to Specifications and Drawings for Construction of
Spot Paint Penstock, Garrison Dam, ND
Solicitation No. DACW45 02 B 0013.

TO: Prospective Bidders and Others Concerned

1. The specifications and drawings for subject project are hereby modified as follows (revise all specification indices, attachment lists, and drawing indices accordingly).

a. Specifications. (Descriptive Changes.)

(1) Section 01001 Page 1, paragraph 2, line 5, after "removal of" add "sections".

(2) Section 01400 Page 2, paragraph 1.3, line 2, delete "prior to beginning of site work." And substitute "within 10 days following NTP."

(3) Section 13280 Page 9, paragraph 1.3.1,
a) line 3, delete "3." and substitute "4."
b) Following the first sentence, add "The Corrosion and Asbestos Location Details for Penstocks 1, 2, & 3 contain notes indicating whether or not there is asbestos abatement required on either the upstream or downstream side of each saddle. In addition, there is asbestos abatement (and painting) required at the top of all saddles on both ends of each saddle for Penstocks 1, 2, 3, & 4. See Drawing MGR284-082, Sheet Reference Number MA.02, for details of that additional abatement and paint requirements."

(4) Section 09965 Page 1, paragraph 1, line 5, delete "All existing surfaces, except those with vinyl paint, have lead present." and substitute "Assume all existing penstock coatings contain lead."

b. Specifications (New). Add specification pages as noted below. The new pages are issued with this amendment.
