TO: Prospective Bidders and Others Concerned

1. The specifications and drawings for subject project are hereby modified as follows (revise all specification indices, attachment lists, and drawing indices accordingly).

a. Specifications. (Descriptive Changes.)

(1) Page 00010-1, delete date and time of bid opening shown and substitute "11 July 2002" at "2:00 p.m.".

(2) Page 00010-1, Item 11 and Section 00800, Page 1, paragraph 1.1, line 4, delete "120 calendar days" and substitute "180 calendar days".

(3) Section 01040, Page 4.

(a) Paragraph 1.2, lines 7 and 8, delete  
"(<ftp://ftp.usace.army.mil/> ... for AutoCADD and".

(b) Paragraph 1.4.1, line 4, after "15 percent of the total project drawings", insert: "These drawings shall be sheets used for the construction of this project (excludes the cover sheet, the vicinity map and the location map)."

(4) Section 01040, Page 5, paragraph 1.4.1, line 1 from top of page, after "One (1) full size", insert "set".

(5) Section 01040, Page 6, delete paragraph 1.4.3.3 in its entirety.

(6) Section 06100, Page 7, delete paragraph 3.4 in its entirety.

(7) Section 08210, Page 2, paragraph 1.2, SD-04 Samples, submittal item for "Door finish colors", delete "G, RE" and substitute "G, ED".

(8) Section 09200, Page 3, paragraph 2.1.1, delete lines 3 thru

8 reading "Color: White ... full coverage" and substitute:

"Color: White.  
Texture (Finish): Splatter Knockdown.  
Aggregate: Polystyrene.  
Dilution (water): 4-5/ 50 (gal/ pound).  
Coverage: Up to 40 square feet per pound or as required to  
achieve full coverage."

(9) Section 09250, Page 7, delete paragraph 3.4 in its  
entirety.

(10) Section 09510A, Page 3, paragraph 1.2, SD-04 Samples,  
submittal item for "Acoustical Units", delete "G, RE" and substitute "G, ED".

b. Specifications (New). Add the specification section as noted  
below. The added specification section is issued with this amendment.

## PART 1 GENERAL

## 1.1 REFERENCES

The publications listed below form a part of this specification to the extent referenced. The publications are referred to in the text by basic designation only.

U.S. NATIONAL ARCHIVES AND RECORDS ADMINISTRATION (NARA)

40 CFR 247 Comprehensive Procurement Guideline for  
Products Containing Recovered Materials

## 1.2 OBJECTIVES

Government procurement policy is to acquire, in a cost effective manner, items containing the highest percentage of recycled and recovered materials practicable consistent with maintaining a satisfactory level of competition without adversely affecting performance requirements or exposing suppliers' employees to undue hazards from the recovered materials. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has designated certain items which must contain a specified percent range of recovered or recycled materials. EPA designated products specified in this contract comply with the stated policy and with the EPA guidelines. The Contractor shall make all reasonable efforts to use recycled and recovered materials in providing the EPA designated products and in otherwise utilizing recycled and recovered materials in the execution of the work.

## 1.3 EPA DESIGNATED ITEMS INCORPORATED IN THE WORK

Various sections of the specifications contain requirements for materials that have been designated by EPA as being products which are or can be made with recovered or recycled materials. These items, when incorporated into the work under this contract, shall contain at least the specified percentage of recycled or recovered materials unless adequate justification (non-availability) for non-use is provided. When a designated item is specified as an option to a non-designated item, the designated item requirements apply only if the designated item is used in the work.

## 1.4 EPA PROPOSED ITEMS INCORPORATED IN THE WORK

Products other than those designated by EPA are still being researched and are being considered for future Comprehensive Procurement Guideline (CPG) designation. It is recommended that these items, when incorporated in the work under this contract, contain the highest practicable percentage of recycled or recovered materials, provided specified requirements are also met.

## 1.5 EPA LISTED ITEMS USED IN CONDUCT OF THE WORK BUT NOT INCORPORATED IN

## THE WORK

There are many products listed in 40 CFR 247 which have been designated or proposed by EPA to include recycled or recovered materials that may be used by the Contractor in performing the work but will not be incorporated into the work. These products include office products, temporary traffic control products, and pallets. It is recommended that these non-construction products, when used in the conduct of the work, contain the highest practicable percentage of recycled or recovered materials and that these products be recycled when no longer needed.
