COLORADO.

TO: Prospective Offerors and Others Concerned

1. The specifications and drawings for subject project are hereby modified
as follows (revise all specification indices, attachment lists, and drawing
indices accordingly).

a. Specifications. (Descriptive Changes.)

- (1) Amendment #0004, page 5, item 14, in the paragraph "Replace
existing...than 4 inches," in the second sentence delete "105, 106,
and 108" and substitute "106, 107, and 108".
- (2) Section 00110, page 5, paragraph 6.e.(7).(d), delete "Fails
to meet" and substitute "Barely meets".
- (3) Section 01006, page 17, paragraph 2.6.1, delete last sentence
of this paragraph ("Grounds...separate meter.") and substitute the
following new sentence:

"Golf Maintenance portion of Bldg. 200 shall have one separate meter for
Building 200 only."

- (4) Section 01006, page 23, paragraph 2.7.7, in second sentence
("Each building...meter.") and substitute the following new
sentence:

"Each building shall be metered separately with the Golf Maintenance Equipment
Portion of Building 200 having a separate meter for Building 200 only."

- (5) Section 01007, page 13, paragraph 1.10.1.2, first sentence
("Metering shall...Facilities."), delete text "the in new Golf
Maintenance & Grounds Maintenance Facilities" and substitute the
following new text:

"for Building 200. The metering for the Golf Maintenance Facility and Grounds
Maintenance Facility shall be separate so each will have its own meter."

(6) Section 01007, page 24, paragraph 1.16.1 (added by Amendment #4), add the following text to this paragraph:

"Contractor shall provide a new flow switch in the existing and new part of the sprinkler system to alarm the new fire alarm panel when the sprinkler system is set into flow."

(7) Section 01008, page 6, after paragraph 1.2.4, add the following new paragraph:

"1.2.4.1 Building 200

The sprinkler system in building 200 is existing and has an existing backflow preventer. The existing system shall be modified to meet the layout of the new conditions within the building. For the new building addition a new dry pipe system shall be installed and tied into the existing header downstream of the backflow preventer. The new addition will be unheated and thus the dry pipe system is required."

b. Drawings (Not Reissued). The following drawings are revised as indicated below with latest revision date of 3 August 2004. These drawings are not reissued with this amendment.

(1) Sheet U1.01, to existing sanitary sewer line, add ` 4" `. See also Sheet C4.02 with the latest revision date of 7/23/04.

(2) Sheet A1.02, in "ROOM MATERIAL AND FINISH SCHEDULE", room 105, under "FLOOR", delete "3" (porcelain tile) and substitute "2" (resilient tile).

(3) Sheet EU.01, at note "EXISTING FAA CABLE...JUNCTION BOXES", add the following the following new notes to this note:

"NOTES

1: EXISTING FAA CABLE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) 1, 50 PAIR & 1, 25 PAIR OF #19 TWISTED PAIR SOLID COPPER
 - 2) 2, 12-PAIR OF #19 TWISTED PAIR SOLID COPPER
 - 3) 1, 25-PAIR OF #19 TWISTED PAIR SOLID COPPER WIRE
- ALL CABLE IS ARMOR SHIELDED DIRECT BURIED.

2: FOR FAA CABLE WORK, A WORK PLAN SHALL BE FIRST PREPARED FOR APPROVAL BY THE BASE, THE LOCAL FAA, AND THE CONTRACTING OFFICER'S REPRESENTATIVE, PRIOR TO WORK START, IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE DOWN TIME.

3: THE NEW FAA CABLE WORK SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO SPLICING INTO THE EXISTING FAA CABLING."

2. This amendment is a part of the proposing papers and its receipt shall be acknowledged on the Standard Form 1442. All other conditions and requirements of the request for proposal remain unchanged. If the proposals have been mailed prior to receiving this amendment, you will notify the office where proposals are received, in the specified manner, immediately of its receipt and of any changes in your proposal occasioned thereby.
